Philemon Vs 8-14

We continue to look into Paul’s shortest letter packed with priceless teaching in:

- A) Practical Righteousness
- B) Christian Brotherhood
- C) Christian Courtesy
- D) The Law of Love

Our first “take away and apply” portion of scripture was in V2: “the church in thy house”. Is there a church in our house? If so, is it well ordered? Does it promote Godliness, holiness, kindness and love? Are we careful to attend to the welfare of the souls of our family members; discipling the saved and praying for the lost?

Our second “take away and apply portion of scripture was in V7: “because the bowels of the saints are refreshed by thee, brother”. Does our life bear evidence that we have faith toward the Lord Jesus which produces love toward all the saints? Have the saints been encouraged and refreshed having been in our presence?

Today, in Vs 8-14, we find more “take away and apply” portions of scripture pertaining to Christian brotherhood, courtesy and love.

Please read this letter weekly. Look back, refresh your memory as to what we have studied; look forward for the priceless teachings listed above; attempt to identify our “take away and apply” portion of scripture for our remaining studies of Vs 15-17; Vs 18-25.

**“Remembering What God Remembers”**

“I remember thee, the kindness of thy youth, the love of thine espousals...”

(Jer. 2:2 KJV)

Questions:

Am I as kind to God as I was when I first became a Christian, or...? Was there ever a time when I loved the Lord Jesus more than I love him now or...? When God looks into my heart, or reads the thoughts of my mind, or discerns the mood of my spirit, does he have cause to rejoice, or.....?

You are not in love with me now, says God to his people in Jer. 2:2; but I remember the time you were. God delights in his people and Christ delights in His church. To our shame, we may not often remember Him; but to His glory, He never ceases to remember us.

Oswald Chambers writes: “There is no joy in the soul that has forgotten what God prizes. If, as I recall what God remembers about me, I find He is not what He used to be to me, let it produce shame and humiliation, because that shame will bring the godly sorrow that works repentance”. (*My Utmost for His Highest, Oswald Chambers*).

“For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death”. (2 Corinthians 7:10 KJV)
