True or False?

Titus 1: 10-16

The first study in Titus (Vs 1-4) focused on the Ministry of God's servants. There is a) The Minister; b) The Mission; c) The Message; and d) The Motivation of Ministry.

The previous verses studied last week addressed the proper appointment of those Elders who were doing the preaching and teaching, "to set in order the things wanting" (V5-9). The Biblical qualifications for Elders are divided into 3 categories: A) His Family Qualifications (V6); B) His Personal Qualifications (V7-8); and C) His Preaching Qualifications (V9).

Today we focus on the subject of Teachers, and they are divided into two categories: True or False. The false teacher, Satan's minister has his ministry, his mission, his message and his motivation as well. How can we identify them? What power do they have? What must we do about them? The answers can be found in our subject text for today, Ti 1:10-16. Ps 139:7-8; 103:14; 51:17; Heb 4:12; 12:6; Job 38; 1Sam 15:22; 1Cor 4:2; 1Jn 1:9; Pr 3:6

Orthodoxy versus Heterodoxy (Acts 2:2)

"Without biblical authority, or any other right under the sun, carnal religious leaders have introduced a host of attractions that serve no purpose except to provide entertainment for the retarded saints.

It is now common practice in most evangelical churches to offer the people, especially the young people, a maximum of entertainment and a minimum of serious instruction. It is scarcely possible in most places to get anyone to attend a meeting where the only attraction is God. One can only conclude that God's professed children are bored with Him, for they must be wooed to meeting with a stick of striped candy in the form of religious movies, games and refreshments.

This has influenced the whole pattern of church life and brought into being a new type of church architecture, designed to house the golden calf.

So, we have the strange anomaly of orthodoxy in creed and heterodoxy in practice. The striped-candy technique has been so fully integrated into our present religious thinking that it is simply taken for granted. Its victims never dream that it is not a part of the teachings of Christ and His apostles". *MDP135-136*
