"The Curse, The Cup, The Cross"

(Multiple Scripture listed below)

Through the month of April our Sunday study of the Scriptures will focus on the Ministry and Mission of Christ, including His suffering and His sacrifice, and how it relates to us if we are to imitate our Savior, Jesus Christ and take up our cross.

Last Sunday we focused on His Ministry, Mission and Message to preach the gospel to the poor, to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captive, to recover sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised and to preach the acceptable year of the Lord to "The Least, the Last and the Lost of Society".

Today we will focus on some events in the week of the life of Christ that began on what we observe as Palm Sunday which will involve The Curse, The Cup and The Cross.

"The Cross for the Christian"

(The following are partial excerpts from the works of AW Tozer)

"The cross is the suffering the Christian endures as a consequence of following Christ in perfect obedience. Christ chose the cross by choosing the path that led to it; so, it is with His followers. In the way of obedience stands the cross. We take the cross when we enter that way." (The Radical Cross)

"We must invite the cross to do its deadly work within us. We must bring our self-sins to the cross for judgment. We must prepare ourselves for suffering in some measure like that through which our Savior passed when He suffered under Pontius Pilate.

Let us remember: when we talk of the rending of the veil we are speaking in a figure, and the thought of it is poetical, almost pleasant; but in actuality there is nothing pleasant about it. In human experience that veil is made of living spiritual tissue; it is composed of the sentient, quivering stuff of which our whole beings consist, and to touch it is to touch us where we feel pain. To tear it away is to injure us, to hurt us and make us bleed. To say otherwise is to make the cross no cross and death no death at all. It is never fun to die.

To rip through the dear and tender stuff of which life is made can never be anything but deeply painful. Yet that is what the cross did to Jesus and it is what the cross would do to every man to set him free." (*The Pursuit of God*)
