**"A Marriage in the Making Pt 2; the Acceptance"**  
Ruth 3:10-18

In Chapter 1, Elimelech took his wife Naomi and their two sons to the forbidden country of Moab. The father dies; the two sons marry and die there. One daughter in law, Ruth, returns to Bethlehem with her mother in law, Naomi; having forsaken her gods for the One True God under whose wings she has come to trust.

In Chapter 2 we learn that God has provided for them in a miraculous way through the hand of Boaz, in whose eyes Ruth has found grace; and Boaz has offered Ruth his provision and protection.

In Chapter 3, having been informed by Ruth of their good fortune, right away Naomi sees "A Marriage in the Making"; and in our last study, Ruth has made her proposal according to the Mosaic Law.

Today, Boaz will accept; but OOPS, there is a "hitch". Yes, Murphy's Law existed even then!

*(The following is a partial excerpt from the works of  
AW Tozer)*

"The work of Christ on the cross did not influence God to love us, did not increase that love by one degree, did not open any fount of grace or mercy in His heart. He had loved us from old eternity and needed nothing to stimulate that love. The cross is not responsible for God's love; rather it was His love which conceived the cross as the one method by which we could be saved. God felt no different toward us after Christ had died for us, for in the mind of God Christ had already died before the foundation of the world.

God never saw us except through atonement. The human race could not have existed one day in its fallen state had not Christ spread His mantle of atonement over it. And this He did in eternal purpose long ages before they led Him out to die on the hill above Jerusalem. All God's dealings with man have been conditioned upon the cross." — *A.W. Tozer, The Radical Cross: Living the Passion of Christ*
